Prayer in the petition is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to transfer the investigation to the Crime Branch or constitute a Special Investigation Team (S.I.T.) for conducting fair, free and impartial investigation in case bearing FIR No. 57 dated 05.06.2022 registered under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149 IPC, Section 326 IPC added later on, at Police Station 'D' Division, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar, against the private respondents against whom two FIRs have already been registered by the petitioner.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has given a representation dated 04.07.2022 to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, and restricts his prayer to

the extent of issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner at the earliest.

Notice of motion to the respondent-State only, at this stage.

Learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have also gone through the documents on record.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into the matter and decide the representation dated 04.07.2022 of the petitioner, in accordance with law.
