Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.162 dated 15.3.2022 registered under Sections 323, 342, 365, 397, 506, 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (Sections 324 IPC and Sections 25(1-B) and 27 of Arms Act added later on) at Police Station Old Industrial, Panipat, District Panipat.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the matter has been compromised between the parties and further, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in light of previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.

Counsel appearing for the complainant has admitted the factum of compromise which has been effected between the parties and he has

further pleaded no objection if the present petition is allowed.

State counsel on instructions from SI Bansi Lal has admitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required by the police for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 1.8.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
