The petitioner has assailed the order dated 30.05.2022 (Annexure P-27) whereby the complaint filed by the petitioner in regard to application for grant of licence to respondents No.7 to 12 has been dismissed by respondent No.3- Director, Urban Local Bodies, Haryana.

Mr. Sharma has assailed the order on a number of grounds. There is no need to refer to any of these in view of the fact that as per Section 19 of the Haryana Development and Regulation of Urban Areas Act, 1975 (in short 'the Act') any person aggrieved by an order of the

Director may within thirty days of the communication of the order to him prefer an appeal to the Secretary to Government, Haryana, Town and Country Planning Department.

In view thereof, this petition is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to file an appeal in terms of Section 19 of the Act within a period of two weeks from today. If such an appeal is filed, the Appellate Authority would consider and decide the appeal without going into the question of limitation.

It would also be open to the petitioner to file any application for interim relief which we would request the Appellate Authority to dispose of within a period of one week.
