AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This is a petition seeking regular bail in FIR No. 130 dated 26.4.2021, under Sections 324, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonipat.

As per the case set up, an incident took place on 25.4.2021. During function of a marriage, exchange of hot words resulted in an altercation. It was alleged that petitioners-Ravi @ Tiger and Naveen @ Meena inflicted knife blows.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are in custody since 1.6.2021, the complainant and eye-witness were examined, they have not supported the case of the prosecution. The contention is that the petitioners are not involved in any other case.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer for grant of bail. She submits that the injuries with sharp edged weapons were inflicted on the complainant, however on instructions is not disputing the contention

raised by learned counsel for the petitioners that the eye-witness and the complainant have not supported the case of the prosecution.

Without commenting on the merits of the case or on the deposition made by the eye-witness and the complainant, having conspectus of the facts, nature of allegations, the petitioners have no criminal antecedents, though the investigation is complete, conclusion of trial is likely to take time, the petitioners are granted bail subject to their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
