GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.331 dated 13.8.2021 at Police Station Sadar Nuh, District Nuh under Sections 3 and 13(1) of Haryana Gauthansh Sanrakshan and Gauthamvardhan Act, 2015.
2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion 03.09.2021, the following order was passed:

“The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.331 dated 13.08.2021 at Police Station Sadar Nuh, District Nuh under Sections 3 and 13(1) of Haryana Gauthansh Sanrakshan and Gauthamvardhan Act, 2015.

As per the case of prosecution, a secret information was received to the effect that a person named as Ramjan alias Kanhya was involved in cow slaughtering and if a raid is conducted, he could be caught red handed. It is further the case of prosecution that upon receipt of said information a raid was conducted at the

nominated place from where 50 kgs. of beef, a weighing scale, 4 weights, 2 knives and one axe was recovered, whereas the petitioner fled away from the spot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case and it is highly unlikely that the police despite receipt of secret information could not nab the petitioner, who is alleged to have fled away right under the nose of police officials.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.
4. Having regard to the aforestated position, wherein the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 03.09.2021 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
