Prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in Criminal Case having FIR No.793 dated 18.12.2005 registered under Sections 307, 323, 285, 266, 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act-1959 at Police Station NIT Faridabad District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner in the present case has been attributed no injury and the petitioner is languishing behind the bars for last more than ten months and the trial is yet to commence. So, prayer is made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

The present petition is contested by the State counsel who on instructions from ASI Pardeep Kumar has not disputed the custody period of the petitioner and further submits that earlier the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender. However, the State counsel has not disputed the fact that after presentation of challan. Charges have not been framed till date.

I have considered the submissions made by the counsel for the parties.

As per the custody certificate furnished by the State counsel, the

custody of the petitioner is more than ten months and trial is yet to commence after framing of charges, as has been admitted by the learned State Counsel. No one sustained injuries at the time of the occurrence in question and further it will take considerable time for the trial to conclude. No purpose is going to be served by prolonging the judicial custody of the petitioner for any longer period.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
