In view of the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the hearing of the main petition is preponed from 16.09.2022 and the same is taken up on board today itself.

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.623 dated 25.08.2020 registered at Police Station HTM Hisar, District Hisar, under Sections 147/149/323/342/427/506 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 03.09.2021, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Two separate reports of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hisar, have been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners, namely, Narender Kumar, Ravi, Anant Ram & Sawatri and also of accused/petitioner Sachin (being juvenile) as well as of complainant Sujata have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
4. The complainant Sujata in her statements has stated that she has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hisar, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any pressure.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.623 dated 25.08.2020 registered at Police Station HTM Hisar, District Hisar, under Sections 147/149/323/342/427/506 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
