The petitioner has impugned the order dated 05.02.2014 (Annexure P-11) whereby the claim of the petitioner for grant of compassionate appointment has been declined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the father of the petitioner, who was working as an Assistant Lineman, had expired in the year 2001. The petitioner was a minor at that time and his mother had sought employment for the sister of the petitioner but the same was declined by the respondents. He further submits that the case of the petitioner for financial assistance in terms of the policy of the respondents has not been considered and the petitioner may be permitted to make a representation to the respondents in this regard.

Heard.

The petitioner was a minor when his father had expired. The mother of the petitioner had sought appointment on compassionate ground for

the sister of the petitioner which had been declined and the case of the petitioner for appointment on compassionate ground has also been declined by the impugned order (Annexure P-11) on account of delay. A Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 07.03.2017 had issued notice to the respondents only to the extent of financial assistance.

It is indeed an unfortunate case of the petitioner who was a minor when he had lost his father. The respondents have not taken any decision with regard to the financial assistance payable to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a representation to the respondents for grant of financial assistance and in the event of the representation being made, the same shall be considered and decided by respondent No.2 in accordance with law within a period of three months from its receipt. In the event the petitioner is found entitled to the financial assistance, the same shall be released to him within a period of two months thereafter.
