Appellant-Insurance company has filed these appeals to challenge the common award dated 02.04.2019, passed by the Motor Accidents Claim Tribunal, Kaithal, in MACT case Nos.27 to 30 of 2018, whereby compensation of Rs.17,83,600/-, Rs.2,50,000/-, Rs.2,50,000/- and Rs.12,26,068/-, respectively along with the interest @ 9% per annum was awarded to claimants towards death of four persons, in a vehicular accident.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that Nishan Singh and his other family members, namely, Sarvjeet Kaur (wife), Jasveer (son) and Khushpreet Kaur (daughter) died in a vehicular accident and four separate claim petitions were filed by claimants (respondent Nos.1 & 2) for compensation under Section 166 Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

He further states that though these appeals were filed during the breakout of pandemic COVID-19, but as during the pendency of these appeals, the awarded amount of compensation stands disbursed to the claimants, therefore, the appeals be dismissed.

Ordered accordingly.
