Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 41 dated 08.05.2021, registered under Sections 353, 186, 427, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in the present case; that information was given through mobile phone by Baljit Singh-Sarpanch of the village that a mob of the village Karma was gathered to encroach the village land; that there is a delay of two days in lodging the FIR and that though the petitioners were specifically named in the FIR, yet no specific injury has been attributed to him.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have also gone through the paper-book.

As per the prosecution, when the police party reached at the spot, 17 named persons, including the petitioners, and 30/40 unknown persons armed with baton and bricks were present there and on seeing the police party they attacked upon the vehicle of the police party. The petitioners along with other co-accused, armed with deadly weapons, caused hindrance to the police party in discharge of their official duty and have also taken law in their hands, if the petitioners are granted the concession of anticipatory bail, it would encourage such type of anti social elements. Bail petition of co-accused Madan, has already been dismissed by this Court vide order dated 25.07.2022.

Considering the very nature of the allegations contained in the FIR, the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is necessary. The petitioners do not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
