The appellant has challenged the Award dated 02.5.2019 passed by learned MACT, Sonapat, wherein a 'meager' sum of compensation has been awarded in favour of the appellant.

Learned counsel for the appellant/injured submits that only Rs.8000/- has been awarded as total compensation. Learned counsel for the appellant/injured further states that only Rs.2000/- has been given for mental pain and agony.

Admittedly, there were only simple injuries caused to the appellant/injured in the accident i.e. five simple injuries on right foot, below right knee, lower back left side, left elbow and right gluteal region. Even no medical bills have been submitted by the appellant. Accordingly, I find

that very reasonable amount has been given to the appellant/injured as compensation by the learned Tribunal.

Accordingly, I find no merits in the appeal and the same is hereby dismissed.
