The appellant has challenged the Award dated 02.5.2019 passed by learned MACT, Sonapat, wherein a meager sum of compensation has been awarded in favour of the appellant.

Learned counsel for the appellant/injured submits that only Rs.13,500/- has been awarded as total compensation. Learned counsel for the appellant/injured further states that the appellant/injured has suffered fracture in second metacarpal bone of right hand coupled with the injuries over left knee and right side of chest, as mentioned in the MLR Ex.PW1/D. appellant/injured is stated to be 47 years old. Learned counsel for the appellant/injured submits that nothing has been awarded under the head of reduction in life expectancy and only Rs.2000/- have been granted for special diet.

After hearing learned counsel for the appellant/injured and perusing the records, I find that the appellant was admitted in hospital for only one day and has submitted medical bills Ex.P-21 to P-24 for only Rs.2130/- spent on her treatment. As such, I find that very reasonable amount has been granted to the appellant/injured as compensation by the learned Tribunal.

Accordingly, I find no merits in the appeal and the same is hereby dismissed.
