NIDHI GUPTA J.(Oral)

The appellant has challenged the Award dated 02.5.2019 passed by learned MACT, Sonapat, wherein a 'meager' sum of compensation has been awarded in favour of the appellant.

Learned counsel for the appellant/injured submits that only Rs.15,000/- has been awarded as total compensation on account of four injuries received by the appellant i.e. on shoulder, left elbow, back left side and left glutial region.

A perusal of the impugned Award shows that as per MLR Ex.PW1/C of appellant/injured Sunil shows that he sustained only four simple injuries on shoulder, left elbow, back left side and left glutial region, however, he has not sustained any fracture in the said incident. He has placed on record medical bills Ex.P6 to Ex.P9, which show that a sum of

Rs.1741/- was spent on his treatment. No other bill regarding treatment expenses has been placed on record. Therefore, a sum of Rs.2000/- towards medical bills; Rs.2000/- towards attendant charges; Rs.2000/- towards conveyance charges; Rs.2000/- towards special diet; Rs.5000/- towards loss of income; and Rs.2000/- towards mental pain and agony, in total Rs.15,000/- alongwith interest @8% per annum from the date of filing of petition till realization of amount has been awarded to the appellant/injured.

Admittedly, there were only simple injuries caused to the appellant/injured in the accident i.e. four simple injuries on shoulder, left elbow, back left side and left glutial region and no fracture has been caused to the appellant/injured in the said incident. Accordingly, I find that very reasonable amount has been awarded to the appellant/injured as compensation by the learned Tribunal.

Accordingly, I find no merits in the appeal and the same is hereby dismissed.
