The appellant has challenged the Award dated 02.5.2019 passed by learned MACT, Sonapat, wherein a meager sum of compensation has been awarded in favour of the appellant.

Learned counsel for the appellant refers to the Award to show that admittedly the claimant/injured was in hospital from 22.3.2017 to 25.3.2017, which is only two days. She claims to have spent Rs.2,00,000/- on the treatment of claimant/injured but had only placed on record medical bills Ex.P13 to P18 for a sum of Rs.3450/-, which has been duly awarded to the appellant/claimant. Further, under the loss of income, Rs.16,000/- was granted by the Tribunal to the appellant being the labourer. Learned counsel is seeking enhancement of compensation on the ground that the appellant is still undergoing the treatment, however, is unable to show

anything in this regard.

Accordingly, I find no merits in the appeal and the same is hereby dismissed.
