On 05.08.2022 following order was passed in the main case:

“Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.111 dated 12.04.2020 under Sections 365, 342, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh (Mewat.)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that during the course of investigation the petitioner was found innocent. However, he has been summoned in terms of the order dated 22.11.2021 passed by the learned trial Court on the application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. Furthermore, co-accused namely Tahir has been granted regular bail by the trial Court and next date of hearing in the trial Court is 22.08.2022.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Trishanjali Sharma, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court on or before 22.08.2022 and on his doing so, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 20.10.2022.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of interim directions, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court on

Learned State counsel has not assailed the aforesaid factual aspect.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 05.08.2022, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall furnish fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate within a period of one month. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
