The petitioner has failed in Class-IX examination. According to him, the result is incorrect as according to the revised promotion policy circulated by the CBSE, he would have passed only on the basis of his term-I examination. Thus, representation dated 13.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) has been submitted before respondent No.3 and other officials, but no action has been taken thereupon, till date. Thus, a direction may be issued to respondent No.3 to decide the pending representation by passing a speaking order.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, no reply is necessary.

The writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3 to decide the pending representation dated 13.04.2022 (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
