Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the selection list, vide which respondent No.4 was selected for the post of Peon in pursuance of the advertisement dated 08.04.2017 (P-11).

Respondent No.4, who is present in person, produced the photocopy of her Aadhaar Card and specifically stated that she would not be interested for joining on the post in question.

Faced with the above situation, learned Counsel for the petitioner does not press the petition any more.

Disposed off accordingly.

However, it is made clear that in case something survives, petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
