Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.57 dated 24.05.2021, registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act and Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later on, at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 02.09.2021, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 02.09.2021, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from – SI Jaswant Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.09.2021, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
