MAIN CASE

The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the official respondent to initiate appropriate action under Section 182 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 against respondent No.8 – Smt. Navanshee Bansal for her inappropriate deeds of knowingly lodging false complaints with the police regarding which the representation through e-mail dated 16.06.2022 (Annexure P-6) and representations dated 12.07.2022 (Annexures P-8 to P-10) stand filed by the petitioner, in the interest of justice.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative and efficacious remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
