Complaining wilful violation of the directions issued on 01.02.2022 passed in CWP-633-2022, the petitioner has filed the present contempt petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

The operative part of the order dated 01.02.2022 reads as under:-

“Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 10.03.2020 (Annexure P-3) and legal notice dated 14.12.2021 (Annexure P-4) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Maur, Joint Director, submits that a lot of record was required to be scanned and the matter will be decided within a period of four weeks, from today.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed in

the present petition.
