In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioners is for stepping up of their pay equivalent to their juniors, who are getting higher pay than the petitioners.

After notice of motion, the respondents have filed reply and in para-3 of the reply, it has been mentioned that out of the total 18 petitioners, claim of the 10 petitioners have been considered and processed keeping in view the documents submitted by them substantiating their claim that their juniors are getting higher pay than those petitioners and the relief has already been extended to them whereas, some of the petitioners have failed to submit the requisite documents with regard to their claim that their juniors in the same district are getting higher pay as compare to the pay being drawn by them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the remaining

08 petitioners are also intend to approach the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation along with the requisite documents substantiating their claim that their juniors in the same district are getting higher pay as compare to the pay being drawn by them.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any of the petitioners, who have not been extended the relief in question so far, approaches the respondents along with requisite documents substantiating their claim that their juniors are getting higher pay than those petitioners, the same will be considered by the respondents in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation and in case after the decision, it is found that the petitioners are entitled for any relief, the same will be extended to them within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation along with the requisite documents.

Ordered accordingly.
