The prayer in the present petition is for quashing of the order dated 12.03.2020 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar, whereby, non-bailable warrants have been issued against the present petitioner due to which the anticipatory bail granted to him in DDR No.64 dated 08.02.2013 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 382, 148, 149 IPC 1860 and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered in FIR No.26 dated 08.02.2013 under Sections 307, 324, 382, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered with Police Station Sadar, Amritsar stands cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were ordered to be forfeited to State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, has submitted that on 23.05.2022, the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, while deciding the application for anticipatory bail of the petitioner, had directed the learned trial Court that in case, the petitioner surrenders before the learned trial Court on or before 31.05.2022, then trial Court should try to

dispose of regular bail application of the petitioner within a span of one week from the date of filing of the bail application. He submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the trial Court but the date already given be extended for another week.

On the other hand, Mr. Davinder Bir Singh, D.A.G., Punjab has stated that he has no objection, in case, the date is extended so that the petitioner may surrender.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the present petition is disposed of. The date, which has been mentioned as 31.05.2022 in order dated 23.05.2022, shall be deemed to be extended till 02.08.2022.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
