The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

On 01.10.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Counsel for the petitioner has contended that the allegations levelled against the petitioner, who is 49 years old lady, in the FIR are totally baseless and sans any details. He submits that the allegation regarding lending of Rs.2.00 lakhs to the petitioner is without any particulars. His argument is that the petitioner is a house wife and there was no reason for her to take a loan from the deceased. He further points out that the alleged incident took place on 30.01.2020 but was never reported to the police till after the deceased expired on 08.02.2020. He has placed reliance on the order dated 09.07.2020 (Annexure P-3) whereby husband and both sons of the petitioner were granted interim bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Harbir Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab who is available on conference call, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the petition has already been served upon the State.

List on 18.12.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, she shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Investigating Officer. She shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation. In view of the above, order dated 01.10.2020, is hereby made absolute.

The petition stands allowed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
