This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR no.0293 dated 04.06.2019 registered under Sections 120-B, 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at Police Station Sector 53, Gurugram and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent no.2-complainant have submitted that in the present case, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has not been filed as yet.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition in case report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. is against the petitioner. He has also prayed that the petitioner be permitted to raise all the pleas, which have been raised in the present petition, in case report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

is against the petitioner and she files the second petition for quashing of the FIR.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

It would be open to the petitioner to raise all the pleas, which have been raised in the present petition and are available to the petitioner, in law. In case the second petition is filed, the said petition would be considered independently, on its merits, in accordance with law.

Pending miscellaneous application, if any, stands disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
