Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.86 dated 08.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) registered at Police Station Fattu Dyinga, District Kapurthala, under Sections 307, 326, 325, 324, 323, 427, 341, 379, 379-B(2), 506, 148 and 149 IPC.

Vide order dated 07.09.2021, passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, it was ordered that no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner. Thereafter, vide order dated 28.10.2021, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

As it is the conceded position, that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the the interim protection granted to the petition vide orders dated 07.09.2021 and 28.10.2021, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
