1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 07.03.2019, in CWP-6139-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 07.03.2019, reveals that CWP-6139-2019, was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 14.02.2019, expeditiously and in any case within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if any amount was found due and payable, to release the same to the petitioner without any delay.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 13.03.2020, the petitioner has been released part payment claimed while for the payment which has been denied, the petitioner has invoked arbitration proceedings and that in the

petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to pursue arbitration proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
