Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.226 dated 05.08.2019 registered under Sections 354, 323, 506, 341, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division City, District Hoshiarpur has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State, wherein, it has been *inter alia* submitted as under:-

“8. That it is submitted that the petitioner is habitual offender and the following cases (are) registered against the petitioner in Police Stations at Hoshiarpur:-

- i. *FIR No.81, dated 23.06.2016, U/s 354, 323, 506, 34 IPC was registered P.S.Sadar, Hoshiarpur and the petitioner was convicted in the present case to undergo R.I., for one year.*
- ii. *FIR No.93, dated 22.05.2018, U/s 354-D, 506, IPC and 67 IT Act was registered at P.S.Model Town, Hoshiarpur and the petitioner was convicted in this case by the Court of Sh. Amit Malhan Ld. CJM, Hoshiarpur on 10.12.2019 to undergo R.I. for 2 years.”*

Faced with the criminal antecedents of the petitioner, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
