The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing the detenues mentioned in Para No.3 of the petition.

Nobody has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

However, the status report/compliance report has been filed by Sub Divisional Magistrate, Kharkhoda, District Sonapat and the same is already taken on record.

Mr. Surinder Kumar Dagar, learned DAG, Haryana has submitted that the site was visited and it was found that neither the complainant nor any other bonded labour or any other person was found on the spot. So far as the wife and daughter of the complainant/petitioner is

concerned, they were found on the spot but they have already gone back to their home and there is no illegal detention at the brick kiln.

Mr. Balkar Singh, Advocate has caused appearance on behalf of respondent No.5, who is the owner of the brick kiln and stated that he has neither detained anybody nor there is any illegal custody of anybody at the brick kiln.

In view of the aforesaid position, no further action is required in the present petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
