Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to ensure the safety of life and liberty of the staff of the petitioner-School as well as its property at the hands of the general public on account of the ongoing agitation/protest by the general public within the premises of the School.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State of Punjab contends that the grievance espoused by the petitioner has already been redressed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid aspect that the dharna/protest is no more being held around the school premises.

In view of the statement made by learned State Counsel and the reply filed on behalf of the respondents, the present civil writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
