The prayer in this petition is for quashing of the order dated 05.07.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala in FIR No.34 dated 29.06.2015 under Sections 324, 323, 341, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 452 IPC added later on) (Annexure P-1) registered at Police Station Sanaur, District Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties and a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. bearing CRM-M-32546-2022 seeking quashing of the FIR, in question, has already been filed.

In view of the order of even date passed in the connected petition i.e. CRM-M-32546-2022, where the aforementioned FIR (Annexure P-1) stands quashed, the present petition seeking quashing of the

impugned order dated 05.07.2022 (Annexure P-2) has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
