RAVI SHANKER JHA, C.J. (Oral)

Though this petition initially related to the charge of fees for the internship training imparted to the veterinary students by the College as well as to the payment of internship allowance of Rs.3500/- pm only in place of Rs.17,000/- pm in terms of the notification dated 30.11.2018, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this stage, he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to approach the respondent authorities by filing a representation in respect of payment of internship allowance in accordance with the notification dated 30.11.2018, issued by Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Hisar (respondent No.1) as the petitioners are the students of an institute that is affiliated to the said University.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent-University submits that in case the petitioners do so, the University shall take up the matter and take a decision thereon expeditiously, preferably within a period of three months, in accordance with law. He also assures that an opportunity of hearing would also be provided to the petitioners, if so required.

In view of the above, the petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
