As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representative-Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant-Darshan Singh s/o Shree Ram.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) in the name of appellant-Darshan Singh s/o Shree Ram. with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

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Appeal stands disposed of.

Ordered accordingly.
