AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed for quashing of FIR No. 96 dated 19.6.2019 registered under Sections 308, 506, 34 IPC, 1860 (Section 307 IPC added later on) registered at P.S. Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga on the basis of compromise.

After arguing for some time and realizing that the quashing of FIR involving Section 307 IPC is sought, on the basis of compromise and in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in **State of Madhya Pradesh vs. Laxmi Narayan and others, 2019(2), RCR (Criminal) 225** there is an issue with regard to the maintainability of the petition, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Since the main case has been withdrawn, the pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
