LISA GILL, J.

Petitioners in this writ petition have applied before the respondent-authorities seeking permission for transfer of Bus No. PB-13-F9917 along with route permit No.894/MBR/02 in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that one of the permit holders, namely Swaran Singh son of Karnail Singh died. An application was submitted before the Regional Transport Authority, Patiala, in accordance with law for granting permission to transfer the bus along with its route permit. However, no action has been taken thereon despite there being no impediment for the said transfer. It is stated that legal notice dated 06.07.2022 (Annexure P-5) in this respect has also been served upon the respondents, but to no avail.

Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab, to whom an advance copy of paper book has been supplied, accepts notice on behalf of both the respondents. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Mr. Anil Kumar, Senior Assistant, O/o Secretary, RTA, Patiala, informs that the matter is under consideration and final decision thereon shall be taken within next 10 days.

Keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the State as above, no further orders are called for at this stage. This writ petition is accordingly disposed of. Needless to say, petitioners are at liberty to avail their remedy in case they are aggrieved of the decision.
