AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of detainee Surjit Singh.

During the pendency of the petition, Warrant Officer was appointed and detainee was released.

The allegations are that of illegal detention whereas the stand taken by the State is that he himself tried to enter in the police station to create a pressure on the police so that the FIR against the co-accused is not pursued.

As the detainee has been released no further directions are called for in the criminal writ petition.

However, in view of the disputed question of fact, the petitioner or the detainee would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievance with regard to illegal detention.
