The petitioner is seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant him promotion to the rank of Assistant Sub Inspector w.e.f. 27.09.2016.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that for his grievance, the petitioner has already served a representation dated 23.02.2022 (Annexure P-4) upon the respondent, but till date no decision has been taken thereon. He would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case said representation is decided, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Pawan Sharda, Senior DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide representation dated 23.02.2022 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
