Prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside order dated 05.07.2019, Annexure P-13, whereby benefit of promotional increment (s) to the petitioner on completion of 23 years of regular service, has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that writ petitions filed by similarly situated persons as the petitioners have been disposed of on 31.05.2022, in **CWP no. 27130 of 2019, titled 'Shavinder Singh Vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Limited and others'** and other connected matters. Petitioner seeks liberty to file representation as has been afforded to the petitioners therein.
