Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as the husband of petitioner No. 1 has still not been declared dead by the competent Court of law on the ground that he has not been seen for the last eight years, the petitioners may kindly be allowed to withdraw this petition, at this stage, with liberty to approach Civil Court for the grant of decree that husband of the petitioner be presumed to be dead so as to entitle the petitioners the grant of benefits in respect of the service rendered by him. Learned counsel for the petitioners also seeks liberty to approach this Court again if granted the benefit by the Civil Court.
