Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the late husband of the petitioner was dismissed from service on the basis of conviction in a criminal case but, later on, on an appeal filed by the late husband of the petitioner, the conviction though, was upheld but, the late husband of the petitioner was released on probation. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that once the late husband of the petitioner was released on probation, order dismissing him from service cannot remain in operation and is liable to the withdrawn.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already approached the respondent No.2-Deputy Commissioner, Hisar by serving a legal notice dated 20.06.2021 (Annexure P/8), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 20.06.2021 (Annexure P/8) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in her legal notice, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 20.06.2021 (Annexure P/8) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
