[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the respondents having failed to comply with the undertaking given before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court leading to passing of order, Annexure P/2 dated 15.10.2019, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law for seeking recall / modification of order, Annexure P/2 dated 15.10.2019 allowing CRM-M No.21243 of 2019 quashing FIR No. 0018 dated 24.01.2019 registered under Sections 34, 406, 420 and 506 IPC at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal against the respondents and to seek dismissal of CRM-M No. 21243 of 2019.

[2] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
