In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the service benefits including the grant of ACP were extended to respondent No.3, who was junior to him, due to which the salary of the petitioner, despite being senior to respondent No.3, was less than respondent No.3. Hence, the respondents were under an obligation to grant the similar benefits to the petitioner as given to his junior.

Learned State counsel submits that after reconsidering the claim of the petitioner, order dated 05.09.2022 has been passed by the respondents granting the petitioner the benefit of the 1st and 2nd ACP by antedating the grant of the said benefit. He further submits that consequential benefits as per the order dated 05.09.2022, if any, will be released to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned State counsel submits that in case even after the grant

of consequential benefits, any grievance of the petitioner still survives, the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation raising the said grievance.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any grievance is raised by the petitioner, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate orders will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such grievance.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, this petition may be disposed of having not been pressed.

Ordered accordingly.
