The instant writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 06.02.2017 (Annexure P-3) whereby, the services of the petitioner stands dismissed without issuing him any show cause notice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that pursuant to advertisement having been issued for recruitment to the post of Constable in Punjab Police, District Amritsar, the petitioner applied for the said post. Being successful in the selection process, petitioner was directed to join the pre-induction orientation course and to report at Kapurthala on 03.12.2016. However, without issuing any show cause notice, the services of the petitioner were dispensed with without affording any opportunity of hearing and, therefore, the petitioner had no option but to approach this Court to have the impugned order set aside.

Pursuant to notice of motion having been issued on 25.05.2017, short reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Dinesh Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters Amritsar Rural dated 30.08.2018 has been filed, wherein it is categorically submitted that the petitioner was never dismissed from District Police Cadre, District Amritsar Rural but was relieved to join the Armed Police Cadre vide office order dated 19.07.2018. In the affidavit it is also submitted that the petitioner has been enrolled as Constable No.7/326 in 7th Indian Reserve Battalion, Kapurthala and is working as such.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Ashok Kumar, Civil Suit Clerk, office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar would submit at bar that currently the petitioner stands transferred/absorbed in the District Cadre of the Commissionerate of Police at Amritsar.

In view of the above submissions made at bar, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant writ petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
