[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 10.07.2018, in CWP No.14466 of 2018.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.14466 of 2018, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 29.09.2017 in accordance with Rules, Regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time, as well as in view of similar order dated 01.05.2017 passed by the respondents, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 05.07.2019 calling for compliance report, the respondent has accepted the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 29.09.2017 and granted benefit to the petitioner as

per her entitlement vide order dated 24.06.2020, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
