The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.140 dated 26.05.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 379-B, 506 IPC, 1860 (Section 325 IPC added later on) with Police Station Saha, District Ambala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 03.08.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 02.09.2022 has been filed on behalf of respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Rajneesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Barara, Ambala and the same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Bhupender Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 03.08.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
