The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.61 dated 30.06.2016, registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 494, 377 IPC at Police Station Lambra, District Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings arising out of it on the basis of a written compromise dated 27.05.2019 (Annexure P-4).

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since petitioners No.1 and 2 have been acquitted by the Trial Court, the present petition qua them has been rendered infructuous.
