The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to employ the petitioner as a Constable in Punjab Police. The petitioner claims that he is a Terrorist Victim Family Category simplicitor and therefore, he is entitled to employment.

It is not in dispute that petitioner's father suffered injuries in a bomb blast which resulted in an FIR on 03.05.1990. At that time, he was in Punjab Police Service. The petitioner's father still continue to be in service. The petitioner claim that certain persons have been given appointment. In response, it has been clarified that three persons have been given employment as their near and dear ones had lost their lives in a terrorist attack, whereas, the remaining three persons have been given appointment as a special case.

In absence of a right, the petitioner is not entitled to issuance of

a writ.

Furthermore, it is nearly 32 years to the happening of the accident/bomb blast. At that time, the petitioner was not even born.

Hence, no ground to issue the writ is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
