Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing impugned order dated 28.02.2017 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.1 exercising the powers of Presiding Officer/ Tribunal under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007 by accepting the petition under Section 22 of the Act *ibid* filed by respondents No.2 and 3 for eviction of the petitioner from the house in question.

While none appears for the petitioner (daughter-in-law) and respondent No.2 (father-in-law), but learned counsel for respondent No.3 (mother-in-law) appears and submits that there has been a compromise amongst the family members. Being so, petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly, with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate application in case compromise *ibid* is not effected.
