1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 28.02.2020, in CWP-7796-2012.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 28.02.2020, reveals that CWP-7796-2012, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Labour Inspector Grade-II, within two months from the date of order keeping in view instructions dated 05.07.2011.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 04.04.2022, passed by respondent No.1. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that in view of the petitioner having been promoted to the post of Labour Inspector Grade-I instead of on the post of Labour Inspector Grade-II i.e. a post higher than the post of Labour Inspector Grade-II, in view of impending abolition of post of Labour Inspector, Grade-II, the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

4. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
