This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 29.03.2017 (Annexure P-4/T) passed by respondent No.2, whereby application filed by respondent No.1 was allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since, the petitioner-senior citizen has already expired, therefore, the present petition or any actionable interest, which could be claimed through the deceased senior citizen in these proceedings, does not survive anymore. Therefore, the present petition is rendered infructuous.
