1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 01.12.2021 in CWP No.24345 of 2021.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.24345 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to decide representation dated 13.11.2019 filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any pecuniary benefits, to release the same to the petitioner within three months thereafter.

3. Learned AAG has produced copy of order dated 21.09.2022 granting 1st ACP scale of Rs.4000-6000 w.e.f. 01.11.2003 and 2nd ACP scale of PB-1 5200-20200+3200 Grade Pay w.e.f 01.12.2013 to the petitioner at par with his junior Sh. Muni Lal, Clerk (Retd.) office of the District Social Welfare Officer, Rewari. Order dated 21.09.2022 is taken

on perusal of the same states that in view of order dated 21.09.2022 and the petitioner having been granted benefits as per entitlement, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
